1. Introduction

ZTE MC315 PCMCIA wireless network card equips with a standard Type II PC Card slot (available on most notebook PCs) and works as a wireless network card, a modem, and a mobile phone. This card allows you to connect to the Internet, send and receive short messages, and make phone calls, without a network cable or phone line.

With the design of the R-UIM card separate from the body, MC315 PCMCIA wireless network card can make the operation more flexible.

3. Care for Your Card

- 1. Protect the card from liquids, dust, or excessive heat.
- 2. Optimal signal strength is usually obtained when the antenna is perpendicular to the card. The antenna could be easily folded down. Do not fold down the antenna in great force or plug the antenna in and out of the card frequently. ZTE shall not be held responsible for the loss due to user's misoperation.
- 3. The card should easily fit into your PC slot. Inserting the card into a slot forcefully may damage connector pins.
- 4. Do not operate the card near any equipment which may be susceptible to electromagnetic interference.



4. Features



Insert R-UIM card to MC315



When MC315 card starts up, the lamp turns YELLOW. After a few seconds, the card will be ready to work, and the lamp turns GREEN.

To remove the card from your computer, please click the button "Safely Remove Hardware";



and then press the button outside the slot. The card will automatically eject out. Do not pull the card out by the antenna.



5. Install and Uninstall

5.1 System Requirements

The MC315 wireless network card can be installed under the either of the following operating system:

- Windows 2000
- Windows XP

Note: Please confirm your earphone is connected with the wireless card when you want to make a voice call.

The dialing pad for the card is displayed when you click the "Voice Call" icon. This performs the same functions as the dialing pad on a mobile phone.

Make a call:

- 1. Please plug the earphone in the card if it is not plugged in the card yet;
- 2. Click "Voice Call" icon;
- 3. Input the number you want to dial by either clicking the number buttons on the dial pad or typing the numbers on your keyboard;
- 4. Click button or press "Enter" key to make a call.

Receive a call:

- 1. Please plug the earphone in the card if it is not plugged in the card yet;
- 2. Click button or press "Enter" key to receive the call;
- 3. Click button or press "ESC" key to end the call.

Redial the last number called:

1. Click button **RL**;

1. When you dial, you can input timed-pause character "P" or "T" by clicking or

- 1. Click "Write SMS" icon on the window;
- 2. Input the message in the field in the left of the window;
- 3. Click "New" button to enter the recipients by typing the phone numbers, or click "Select" button to enter the recipients by selecting from the phone book;
- 4. Enter multiple recipients;
- 5. Select "Priority" and "Valid";
- 6. Click "Send" button to send the message.

Note: The successful sent messages will be stored in the Outbox.

- 4. View the message text in the left of the window.

- 2. Click "New" button on the window;
- 3. Enter the person's name and any phone numbers and/or e-mail addresses in the Contact detail's window;
- 4. Click "OK" to save the entry.

To dial a phone number in the Phone Book:

- 1. Select the entry on the Phone Book window;
- 2. Click "Call" button.

To send a message in the Phone Book:

- 1. Select the entry on the Phone Book window;
- 2. Click "SMS" button.

The Phone Book records can be stored in either PC or R-UIM card. You can copy them from one storage media to another by clicking "Copy" or "Copy all" button.
